I've been contemplating the idea of 'rest' lately. In part, because I spent two weeks lounging beachside (under shade in a vain effort to avoid looking like a lobster). I disconnected from the phone & email, scheduled no meetings more urgent than with a sea turtle and turned off the wake-up alarm. Please don't misunderstand me, it was glorious, but is that what is required to be able to rest? Is rest only obtainable on a tropical island during the days we label 'vacation' on our calendars?

How do you rest in a really busy season of life? Like when you're at the age and stage where you're caring both for the generations above & below you? The WSBC Advisory Council is grateful for the constructive feedback and support our congregation continues to provide, as together we reflect upon these past months and renew our commitment to pursue Gospel-focused ministry together. Your observations about our processes and protocols are helping us as a congregation to even better support our staff, evaluate our leadership styles and prepare for ministry in the next season.

As we continue to grow and learn, we want to invite you to participate in our search for the next Associate Pastor to join our ministry team. All can participate through prayer and we ask you to be intentional about lifting this need before Christ daily. Additionally, some can participate by joining the search committee.

To aid in providing a broad-spectrum of ages, gender, perspectives and roles within the Body, the committee will be composed of one member from each of our four boards, four at-large church members, the Pastor, and at least one alternate. All members must be a covenant member (full or associate) of WSBC.

Members can anticipate meeting an average of twice monthly beginning as early as late July for the first few months. During that time the committee will revise the existing church profile and craft a specific job description for the Associate Pastor. Once the job is posted throughout our denominational, regional & other channels, the committee will likely hit "pause" as we wait for candidates to apply. Regular meetings will then resume for the interview process and, if none are the right fit, the "pause"-then-interview cycle may repeat. The average search process takes 12-18 months. We will have resources available to help the committee through these processes.

At-large members interested in serving are welcome to submit their name to the Advisory Council through me at dehill717@gmail.com by **Sunday, July 7**. Final selection by the Advisory Council will be based on best fit to provide a diverse cross-section of the congregation for the committee.

Mentoring Ministry at WSBC

Why would I find a mentor?

If you want to become a better athlete, you find a coach to refine your skills. Hope to grow in your vocation? You might ask someone who knows the ropes to meet with you regularly. When you need to learn how to manage conflict more effectively, you grab someone who navigates conflict well and ask them to help you identify your blind spots.

We find mentors when we want to grow. And we do the same when we're ready to grow in Christ. So, if you're ready to become more like Jesus as a parent or an employee, in the way you handle your finances or conflict, or how you pray or confront the sin patterns in your life, a mentor can accompany you as together you pursue Jesus.

What is mentoring?

Mentoring simply means giving another brother or sister in Christ access to our lives and inviting them to ask good questions, call us up into who we are in Christ, and speak the Gospel to us over and over again, as together we become more like Jesus. It's pretty simple: You and your mentor meet regularly to talk, study, and pray about either a particular facet of your world or all of your life and pursue Christ together.

Who are mentors at WSBC?

Men & women who are "beggars" willing to tell other "beggars" where the Bread of Life is found. Mentors have been trained to lovingly accompany others in pursuing Christ.

How do I match with a mentor?
